Commercial Applicator Certification If you have ever taken a S.D. commercial certification exam or have ever been licensed as a commercial applicator or dealer in S.D. (even if it has lapsed) you already have an Applicator ID in our database and you should use that 7-digit (barcode) number to log in as an existing applicator.

Commercial Applicator Certification - South Dakota

Commercial applicator certification and licensure is valid for two years and must be renewed by March 1st. A fee of \$35 is charged for a commercial applicator license. Government employees who apply pesticides must obtain a commercial applicator license, but may be fee exempt. The SDDA maintains a searchable database of commercial applicators.

Commercial Applicator License's and category certification is valid for 2 years. License and category certification renewal is required biannually. A fee of \$25 is required at the time of renewal. However, government employees are exempt from the fee. In order to apply pesticides as a commercial applicator you must be certified in the particular category that applies to the purpose of your application.

How to Get Certified as a Pesticide Applicator ...

A commercial applicator license applies to any applicator (whether or not the applicator is a private applicator with respect to some uses) who uses or supervises the use of any pesticide which classified for restricted use for any purpose or on any property other than on property owned by applicator or their employer or under their control or (is applied without compensation other than trading of personal services between producers of agricultural commodities) on the property of another person.
