With the sash supported close to the window opening, pull down the new cord so that it's slack, set it into the groove in the side of the sash and gently nail into place with large blued tacks. Once both sash cords are attached, put the sash back into position and check it operates smoothly, and then reattach the parting bead and baton rod.

Pry off or unscrew the stops (the moldings in front of the lower sash). Pull out the lower sash, and take off the cords or chains on both sides. Knot the cords to keep them from being pulled into the weight pockets. Remove the parting beads (the vertical strips holding the upper sash).

Repair in Workshop. Damage to windows may be so severe that the window sash and sometimes the frame must be removed for cleaning and extensive rust removal, straightening of bent sections, welding or splicing in of new sections, and reglazing.

Lower the sash 4" to 6". The top sash tilt latches will be visible on the top rail. Following the same release procedure as the bottom sash will allow the top sash to be tilted and/or removed for cleaning. Reverse process to replace or reposition sash. NOTE: To tilt the top sash the lower sash must already be either tilted or removed.

The sash can be refinished as desired on the inside and painted on the outside as soon as a "skin" has formed on the putty, usually in 2 or 3 days. Exterior paint should cover the beveled glazing compound or putty and lap over onto the glass slightly to complete a weather-tight seal.

Place the lower sash on the windowsill and cut each cord 3 inches below the hole on each side. Hold each cord firmly against the window to measure the 3 inches. Cut the cord 3 inches below the place where the cords attach to the sides of the lower sash. Reinsert the cords in the sides of the lower sashes.
