Size of the armies at the Battle of Plassey: Clive's army at Plassey comprised 950 European Troops (including 250 men of His Majesty's 39th Foot), 2,100 Indian troops being sepoy and topazes, 60 sailors and 100 artillerymen, with eight 6 pounder guns and two howitzers.
